Do not give your completed worksheet to your employer or payer. Keep it for your records.

**Line 3 of Form TD1 – Age amount**

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2012, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$33,884 and \$78,684, calculate your partial claim as follows:

**Line 9 of Form TD1 – Caregiver amount**

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$15,033 and \$19,435, use column **A**  
If your dependant is **infirm** and their estimated net income for the year will be between \$15,033 and \$21,435, use column **B**

**Line 10 of Form TD1 – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older**
