

ROLE OF THE VICE-CHAIR

The Vice-Chair shall be elected by the Board of Trustees at its October Organizational Meeting, and thereafter at any time determined by the Board, to hold office at the pleasure of the Board for no more than two consecutive terms at a time.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. The Vice-Chair shall act on behalf of the Board Chair, in the latter's absence and shall have all the duties and responsibilities of the Board Chair.
2. The Vice-Chair shall assist the Board Chair in ensuring that the Board operates in accordance with its own policies and procedures and in providing leadership and guidance to the Board.
3. The Vice-Chair shall organize meetings with community organizations as directed by the Board.
4. The Vice-Chair may be assigned other duties and responsibilities by the Board Chair.
