Information for Downhill Skiing

- **If you or a friend are driving your children to the ski hill or picking them up, let us know so we can tell the people who are in charge at the lodge. There will be a sign out sheet as well.**
- If you are bringing your own equipment, have it at the school by 7:30 a.m. and we will transport it to and from the school. **Please put your child's name on all equipment.**
- The busses will leave from the school about 9:00 a.m. and will leave the ski hill at approximately 2:00 p.m. and return to the school for regular bussing schedule.
- Students should pack energy food apart from their lunch.
- If you're going to pick up your child please be sure that **a note is sent with the student,** and advise the teacher supervisor when the student is actually leaving the hill.
- We expect students to behave in an appropriate manner in the lodge.
- Make sure you have an extra pair of dry socks and gloves and that you are dressed properly for the weather (neck warmer (scarves not recommended), gloves, snow pants).
- Helmets are **mandatory** and are available for rent at the ski hill.
- Volunteers are needed. Please call the office if you are able to do so.

Rules

1. No fooling around on lift line.
2. No skiing out of control.
3. **Skiers must stay on the open runs and may not go in the bush.**
4. **Skiers must not go where there are posted "closed" signs or any higher on the hill than instructors tell them.**
5. Ski with a buddy or buddies with the same ability (beginner, intermediate) **and with the adult assigned to your group. You may not ski alone.**
6. You must be present for your ski instruction at the appointed time. You will be told at the ski hill what time your lesson is.
7. Lift tickets will be given to you at the lodge.
8. Students who are breaking the rules on purpose will have their ski tags pulled and will have to stay in the lodge.
9. Teachers/supervisors will inform students of designated ski areas.
