## Alberta Education wants to know what you think...

Alberta Education is conducting the annual Accountability Pillar Survey until mid-February. Parents of students in grades 4, 7 and 10 will receive a survey mailed directly to their home from Alberta Education. Surveys should be returned to Alberta Education, not the school, in the prepaid envelope provided. Students in those grades, along with their teachers, will also be completing the survey online at the school. All surveys are anonymous and no reports will be issued if the number of respondents is fewer than six. Respondents are expected to answer the questions based upon the experiences they have had at their school. We strongly encourage your participation as the results help us identify our school and jurisdiction's strengths and weaknesses. Survey results will be available to jurisdictions by the start of May and will be reported publicly as part of the Annual Education Results reports in the fall of 2012.

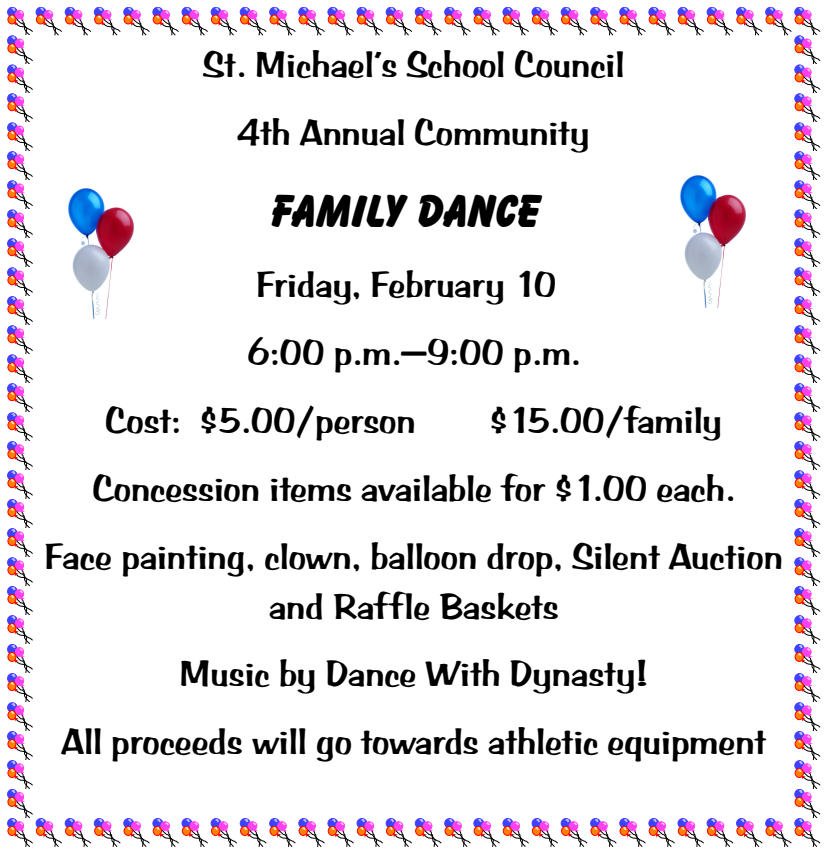
