Textbooks are provided for rental as a convenience for parents & students. Abuse of this service may result in withdrawal of borrowing privileges.

Students may check out one copy of a textbook for themselves. They will not be allowed another unless the first has been returned or paid for.

Textbooks must be returned to the library before or during the time period scheduled for final exams. Late charges of 10 cents per day up to a maximum of \$5.00 per book *may* apply.

Students will be billed for textbooks not returned. A depreciation schedule of 10% per year up to 50% of the replacement value of the book on the fifth and following years will apply.

Students will be billed for damaged textbooks. A damage fee of \$5.00 will be charged for each minor repair. If the repairs per book exceed ½ the cost of the book, replacement cost will be charged as per the depreciation schedule. Removal of or writing on barcodes is considered as damage to the textbook. It may also remove the means of checking the book in which will result in an unreturned textbook and subsequent charges.

Students with outstanding textbooks and/or charges incurred in previous semesters may not be able to sign out textbooks for the new semester.
