Our AISI project over the next 3 years will focus on Mathematics. Our goal is for students to have a deeper conceptual understanding of math. We will involve all students and will track those in grades 3 to 6.

### 2008/09 Student Satisfaction Surveys show they are:

- 86% satisfied with their personal safety at school
- 90.7% satisfied that their school makes them feel cared about as individuals
- 88.4% satisfied with the amount of knowledge and skills they learned
- 90.7% satisfied with the extra help available at the school to help them learn
