

Grad 2012 Pictures

Our photographer this year will be Kurt from Lifetouch in Lethbridge. Since Lifetouch is such a big company, they have been booked until the beginning of next year and therefore our grad pictures will not be until February. Since this is a later than usual date for our school, Kurt has ensured that pictures will be back to us promptly.

Each appointment will be thirty (30) minutes long and will involve both traditional and non-traditional photographs. Traditional photographs will be taken with the cap and gown, and the non-traditional photographs will use props that the student brings (i.e. sports equipment, musical instruments, art supplies, clothing, etc. There will be **no weapons** allowed, as per school policy.) The appointment will be divided in half for each type of photo, with numerous of each being taken. If you choose to do only traditional photos, the whole thirty (30) minute appointment will be in the cap and gown. If you do not want to purchase pictures, please talk to Alyssa Sutter as you will not schedule a full appointment, you will receive three (3) to five (5) head shots in the cap and gown for free. Every grad will need to have their picture taken for the yearbook, even if they are not purchasing pictures.

When you come for your session, please arrive **fifteen (15) minutes early** to ensure you are on time and prepared for your appointment. After your session, you must stay for another **ten (10) to fifteen (15) minutes** to choose the picture you want **in the yearbook**. Choosing your yearbook picture after your appointment ensures you receive the one you want, and cuts down time for the yearbook committee. The sitting fee per session is \$40/student and must be paid by January 16th, 2012.

Proofs will be mailed directly to each student, not through the school. Once you receive the order form, you can order your pictures online or through the mail. Depending when you get your order in, it will take four (4) to six (6) weeks for your pictures to be mailed back to you directly. Lifetouch also offers an "order assistance event" where they will come out one evening and go through the order forms with you if you are having trouble.
